### **NEW RECRUIT COURSE**

11 weeks

HMAS Cerberus, Crib Point VIC (near Melbourne)

Your Navy journey starts at Recruit School where you will learn to be a resourceful and multitasking sailor, while improving your fitness through sports and exercise. Among other subjects you'll learn how to:

- Live and work with a close-knit team
- Conduct uniform maintenance
- Use weapons
- Perform first aid
- Perform ceremonial and drill
- Survive at sea
- Perform basic ships duties

### **INITIAL TRADE TRAINING**

Following graduation from Recruit School you'll start learning the skills of your specific trade, under the guidance of expert military and civilian trainers (for some roles).

This could take you to several locations across Australia, as well as to sea on Navy vessels. Travel opportunities as exciting as these just aren't available in civilian apprenticeships.

Navy trade training is both highly regarded and ongoing, and will equip you with skills and qualifications that will benefit your job prospects wherever life takes you.




