<b>Certificate III</b> Entry to Bachelor Degree	Completing a Certificate III (or higher qualification) can secure you a place of study in a large range of Bachelor degrees.	
<b>Certificate IV</b> Credit (up to 4 units or 6 months)	Completing a Certificate IV or higher qualification allows you to enter into the first or second year of a discipline related Bachelor Degree, with maximum credit, to finish your degree early, saving you time and money.	 <b>Bachelor Degree</b>
<b>Diploma</b> Credit (up to 8 units or 1 year)		
<b>Advanced Diploma</b> Credit (up to 12 units or 1.5 years)		
<b>Graduate Certificate</b> Credit (up to 4 units or 6 months)	Completing a Graduate Certificate or higher qualification allowing you to finish your Masters degree early, and save time and money, as well as boosting your employment prospects.	 <b>Masters Degree</b>
<b>Graduate Diploma</b> Credit (up to 8 units or 1 year)		

Your work or voluntary experience may substitute for holding a tertiary qualification for entry and credit, if you can show you already know, understand and can perform the learning outcomes in a discipline related Bachelor or Masters Degree.


**Gold Coast**
