Credit (up to 4 units or 6 months)

### **Diploma**

Credit (up to 8 units or 1 year)

### **Advanced Diploma**

Credit (up to 12 units or 1.5 years)

Completing a Certificate IV or higher qualification allows you to enter into the first or second year of a discipline related Bachelor Degree, with maximum credit, to finish your degree early, saving you time



### **Graduate Certificate**

Credit (up to 4 units or 6 months)

### **Graduate Diploma**

Credit (up to 8 units or 1 year)

Completing a Graduate Certificate or higher qualification allowing you to finish your Masters degree early, and save time and money, as well as boosting your employment prospects.



Your work or voluntary experience may substitute for holding a tertiary qualification for entry and credit, if you can show you already know, understand and can perform the learning outcomes in a discipline related Bachelor or Masters Degree.


### **Gold Coast**
